Students can access their live online lessons through Google Classroom using a function called ‘Meet’ with a link shared in SMHW. Students should follow the instructions below to access the live online lessons for subjects they study.

Each subject has shared in their SMHW message when the 30 minutes live online lesson is, and the link for attending.

Click on the link just before the session starts, and follow the on-screen prompts. It really is easy. Students will need to be logged into their Google Classroom email account to get into the session as they are linked to student Google Classroom accounts. If a device is still logged into another email account, that email address will not be admitted into the sessions.

Please note that **all sessions will be recorded** for safeguarding purposes and stored securely. Families should be aware of the camera in the room and consider ensuring students have a space without noise or distractions for their lesson time.

Students should stick to the following expectations or unfortunately they will be removed from the sessions.

1. Students should wear appropriate clothing, although this does not have to be school uniform.
2. Students should mute themselves at the start of the session; there will be opportunities to unmute to ask or respond to questions during the session.
3. Students should not interrupt or disrupt the session in any way; if that happens, they will be removed from the session. Students will also be removed if they aren't focused / using mobile phones.
4. Students should be on time for the session, and not join part way through.
5. Students should have a pen and paper ready to make any notes or complete tasks.
6. If requested, students should complete any pre-reading or questions before the session.

Students should message their subject teacher on SMHW if there are any issues.
