# **Superb Support for Year 11**

Year 11 are in a key phase of the most important year of their school life. Mrs Norman, Miss Novelle and all Year 11 teachers are working with every student to help them achieve their absolute best in their summer exams.

Parents play a key part in supporting our Year 11 students and I would like to thank you for your continued support in ensuring your child benefits from the superb support we have in place.

The attendance at after school achieve sessions continues to be above 99%. 14 subject specialist workshops will take place during half term and our Virtual Year 11 Information Evening was well attended and received.

In addition, we received confirmation last week that the vast majority of GCSE examinations will take place from Monday, 7 June to Friday, 2 July 2021, with GCSE Results Day being held on Friday 27 August 2021. In addition, there may be a very small number of examinations before the May half term. This will provide three more weeks of teaching time to help prepare Year 11 students most effectively for their summer exams.

## **Covid Safety and Responding to Positive Test Results**

Our staff have taken time to teach our students on how to keep themselves and others safe. I am so proud of our students for the maturity and care for our community they have demonstrated by following the measures we have in school.

With over 1000 people on our site each day, it was inevitable that at some point we would experience a positive case of Covid-19 within our school community. The fact that we have only had a few confirmed cases in eight weeks is a direct consequence of the efforts that our community have made to reduce the risk of spreading the virus. Should your child test positive for Covid-19 during the half term break, it is essential you email school on <a href="mailto:admin@carletonhigh.patrust.org.uk">admin@carletonhigh.patrust.org.uk</a> and a member of staff will get back to you to gather more information. This will allow us to contact any students who need to self-isolate as a result of being in direct contact with a student who has tested positive.

Moving forward, should we receive confirmation of a positive case, we will only contact the parent/carers of the small numbers of affected students who will be required to self-isolate.

#### **Virtual Parents Evenings**

We are trying to be as innovative as possible, including taking our Parents' Evenings online. We held the Year 7 Welcome Evening this week and it went very well. Thank you to the Year 7 parents who booked an appointment with their form tutor. The feedback was exceptionally positive.

Formal assessments for all year groups are planned for the latter part of next term and this will be used in conjunction with ongoing assessment to inform the mid-term reports which will be issued prior to each parents evening.

# Remote Learning for Self-isolating Students

Whilst it is our intention to continue delivering an exceptional education to all of our students on site, it would be remiss of us not to reflect on the remote learning which has been provided for students who have had to self-isolate this term.

We have been very impressed with the engagement of self-isolating students with both our high quality 'out of lesson' work packs and the live lessons. Feedback from staff and students has told us that students are more engaged and learn more when they have access to live lessons.

Therefore, moving forward, our teaching staff have been honing their skills with live, online teaching to the stage where we will now be delivering 'hybrid' lessons to any classes where students within that class are self-isolating at home. In essence, this means that any student who needs to self-isolate from next half term will be able to follow their normal timetable and join all their lessons live from home with their teacher. All self-isolating students that are fit and well are expected to engage in remote learning using Google Classroom to securely log in to their regular timetabled lessons and tutor time, and participate in a live stream from their own teacher with their own class.
