Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Headteacher End of Term Update.

It has been a real pleasure to welcome students back to Carleton High School this term. With attendance well above the national average and superb engagement in lessons, it is clear how much students have valued being back in classrooms with their friends.

Even with the system of controls still in place, everyone just appears happy to be back. I find myself smiling under my mask when I see students' enthusiasm in lessons, and hear them talking to their friends at social times. This is how school should be and this is what we have missed, we have lots to look forward to now our school community is back together.

Testing

Last week we completed the third round of lateral flow tests for all students who wished to participate. We conducted over 1500 tests in total and all returned negative results. Students have now been able to collect self-test kits for use at home, and should continue to test themselves twice per week over the Easter period.

The organisation and administration of the testing operation has been complex and I would like to thank all members of staff who have contributed to the process.

Awarding of GCSE/Vocational Grades

Since the announcement, we have been planning and focussing on revision for the final end of year assessments. Year 11 students have been given an information booklet containing the dates of the exam window, summary of each exam they will take including key topics to revise, and a blank revision schedule for them to populate. This is to support students with their revision over the Easter holidays and up to



completing their final end of term assessments. We recommend that students spend a **minimum of two hours per day** from now, revising and preparing for their assessments.
