



## KS4 Homework Timetable 2021-22

In Years 10 and 11, students will receive a weekly homework for all subjects each week. For practical based subjects, it may not always be appropriate for homework to be set weekly. In addition to this, Year 11 students will be required to attend 'ACHIEVE' sessions afterschool to further improve their grades.

All pupils have a minimum recommended time they should spend on homework each evening. If pupils have completed all their homework within the minimum recommended time or they do not have any homework to complete on an evening, they are expected to complete independent study. Independent study could be reading for pleasure, as this is proven to improve literacy skills. Other examples of independent study include preparing revision mind maps or other retention devices, completing extra past exam questions or questions from recommended revision guides, etc.
