



## Carleton High School Summer Camp

Carleton High ran a 5 day summer school for Year 6 into Year 7 students with a total number of 42 students attending. The summer school included a mixture of academic education and enrichment activities.

Aims of the summer school:

- To enable students to meet their peers and build relationships.
- So that students could familiarise themselves with the new school setting.
- Allow students to meet staff and build relationships prior to starting Year 7.
- Ensure students are given the opportunity to catch up in Maths & English.

<b>Academic Sessions</b> Students received academic tuition in Maths and English from specialist tutors to catch up on core skills in preparation for their start at secondary school.	£3500
<b>Enrichment Activities</b> Activities provided by experienced staff to build on relationships with peers and get to know staff and the school.	£94
<b>Educational Sessions</b> Students received sessions run by teaching staff in digital art, history, Journalism & Science.	£84.65
<b>Rewards</b> Rewards provided throughout the week to highlight student achievement.	£540
<b>Catering</b> Food and drink provided for students during summer school.	£832.10
<b>Additional Resources</b> Equipment provided for students during academic sessions.	£831.25
<b>Staffing</b> Overtime hours for teaching staff.	£845.95
<b>Leadership</b> Staff leadership time to lead, coordinate and supervise summer school.	£1500
