### Year 10 End of Year Assessments

All students in year ten will complete an end of year assessment in all their subjects. These assessments will take place over a two week period from Monday 6 June to Friday 17 June 2022. The assessments will provide each teacher with in-depth information regarding your child's current progress and understanding of the subject. This information will be used to support your child to improve any areas they may need to. Assessments for English, Maths and Science will take place in the examination hall to prepare students for the experience of their final GCSEs next summer. A timetable of these is below, all other assessments will take place during lesson time, class teachers will inform students when these are.


### Results
