## Year 10 Assessments

I am writing to inform you that Year 10 assessments take place between **Monday 29 January and Friday 2 February 2024**. These assessments are designed to test student understanding of the areas covered to date and will provide class teachers with in-depth information regarding your child's progress. They will also be used to support your child to improve any areas they may need to.

### Student Preparation

In the run up to the assessment, class teachers have and will continue to provide your child with guidance within lessons on what they should be revising and supporting them with how to revise. Staff from the SEND department will be working closely with teachers to ensure that any students who require additional support in their assessments will receive this.
