

Welcome to the first of our monthly news updates for the redevelopment of Carleton High School. Wakefield-based Morgan Sindall Construction have been awarded the contract via the Department for Education framework to deliver the new facilities at the school.

Construction works

The new scheme consists of two phases within the school grounds. Phase 1 involves construction of a new three-storey building located on the existing tennis courts and a new multi-use games area on the school fields. Phase 2 involves the decant and demolition of five existing teaching blocks and associated external soft and hard landscaping works. The Morgan Sindall site will be accessed during the build phase from the existing entrance to the school's visitor car park off Green Lane.

Our works are due to commence following the Easter break in April 2024 with the following:

- Installation of fencing and hoarding
- Start of drainage works
- Start of bulk excavation works
- Construction of new multi-use games area
- Start of concrete foundations and slab works
