Year 11 Mid-Year Report

We would like to invite you to view your child's Year 11 Mid-Year Report. This is the last report they will receive before their GCSE results this summer. Please log in to your My Child At School (MCAS) account to view the report. To access it please select the reports tab.

Teachers have used mock exam results, key marked piece assessments as well as classwork and homework to report on your child's attainment and progress. We look forward to discussing your child's progress in school and their report at parents evening later this week.

An explanation of the report is set out below:

The Report Breakdown:

- The Attitude to Learning (ATL) scores indicate your child's overall ATL in each subject area and ranges from a "1" (Exemplary) to a "4" (Often fails to meet expectations).
- The Year 11 Target Grade indicates the minimum grade that your child should achieve based on their Key Stage 2 data.
- Mock grades are those achieved during the December mock exams. X indicates that a mock exam/s took place but the student missed all or some of the exam/s in that subject.
- The REG is the 'Realistic Expected Grade' we think your child should achieve at the end of Year 11 in their final GCSE and vocational qualifications, based on the most recent end of unit assessments, the mock exam results, classwork and their ATL.
- "Yes" will appear in the homework column if there is an issue with completing homework to a suitable standard or if it is not completed on time. The colour code indicates their progress towards achieving or exceeding their target.
- Excellent attendance is key to good progress and attainment. In light of this, your child's current attendance is included within the report.

We are proud of how our year 11 students have conducted themselves so far on their GCSE journey. The final stages of year 11 are crucial for your child to achieve the best grades possible.
