### Wakefield College Taster Day – Friday 15 March 2024

I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter has been given the fantastic opportunity to visit Wakefield College to experience a Taster Day on **Friday 15 March 2024**.

Students will be departing from school by coach at approximately 8.40am and students will be back at school by 2.35pm. Staff members from Carleton High School will travel to and from the college campuses and will remain there throughout the day.

On the day students will be able to have taster sessions in a number of subjects, which they need to select prior to attending the College. The subjects they select will determine whether they go to the Wakefield or Castleford campus of the College.
