This trip will be an excellent opportunity for students to consolidate their learning on river landforms, erosion and weathering, which are all part of the upcoming river and coasts topics that they will be studying during the summer term.

During the trip we will walk around Malham, visiting Janet's Foss, Gordale Scar and Malham Cove. The trip will depart at 8.00 am and return at approximately 4.30 pm. Please note that this trip is limited to 75 places and will cost £17.60.
