GCSE Geography: Human Fieldwork in Leeds Monday 8 July 2024

In their third Geography GCSE paper students are examined on two pieces of fieldwork in contrasting environments. The work done in Bridlington on 18 June is our Physical Geography piece and the Human element will be covered in a visit to Leeds to look at inequality across the city.

The trip to Leeds will be on Monday 8 July. We will leave school at 9am and be back in time for lunch. On this occasion school uniform will be worn.

The fieldwork trip will include:

- Investigation close to the city centre and Leeds Docks. Leeds is our UK city case study for paper 2 so this is also an ideal opportunity to consolidate learning on the issues and concepts that we have covered in class.
- Exploration of sustainable urban living at the Climate Innovation District.
- Conducting fieldwork surveys at 3 stops along the A64 to compare to compare housing, traffic congestion and noise levels.
- Revision of topics such as urban regeneration, sustainable living, deindustrialisation and factory closure, the impact of globalisation, inequalities across a city and conflict on the rural urban fringe.
